Code of Conduct – 2026 Season

Players, Parents / Carers, Supporters and volunteers guide

At Allstars Netball Club, our goal is to provide a safe, supportive and enjoyable environment where players can develop new skills and grow both individually and as part of a team.

Our community includes players, coaches, managers, scorers, umpires, parents and committee members. While we are proud of our strong and positive culture, we also have clear expectations that must be upheld by everyone.

Please remember that our coaches, managers, many of our umpires, and committee members are volunteers. They generously give their time and knowledge to ensure our players have a fantastic season. Respect for their commitment is essential.

PLAYERS

RESPECT

Players must show respect for:

- Themselves
- Team mates
- Opposing players
- Coaches and managers
- Umpires
- Parents
- Committee members

Respect on and off the court is not negotiable.

BULLYING

Allstars has zero tolerance for bullying of any kind.

Bullying towards team mates, opposing players, umpires, coaches, managers, parents or committee members will not be accepted.

If a player has a concern, they must speak to their coach or manager at a break or after the game — not during play.



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LANGUAGE & BEHAVIOUR

Allstars has zero tolerance for:

- Swearing
- Belittling or discouraging language
- Poor sportsmanship
- Inappropriate behaviour

Players are expected to represent Allstars with pride at all times.

TRAINING & GAME EXPECTATIONS

- Attendance at all trainings is expected unless unwell.
- If unable to attend training or a game, a minimum of 1 hour's notice must be given to the coach or manager.
- This allows time to adjust training plans, positions and team structures.

FAIRNESS OF THE GAME

Netball is a team sport.

No player is to be excluded or discouraged due to friendships, experience levels, or team dynamics. All players will be treated fairly and given opportunities to learn and develop.

100% EFFORT

Players are expected to give their best effort at every training session and every game — for themselves and for their team.

NO MOBILE PHONES

Out of respect for coaches and team mates:

- No mobile phone use during games (including bench time, warm up or debrief).
- No mobile phone use during training sessions.

PARENTS

RESPECT

Parents must show respect for:

- Their child
- All players
- Opposing teams
- Coaches and managers
- Umpires
- Other parents
- Committee members

Positive sideline behaviour sets the standard for our players.



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BULLYING

Allstars has zero tolerance for bullying by parents.

If a concern arises regarding a player, umpire, coach, manager or another parent, this must be addressed calmly with the coach or manager after the game, not during play.

LANGUAGE & BEHAVIOUR

Allstars has a zero tolerance for:

- Swearing
- Aggressive or belittling comments
- Disruptive or inappropriate behaviour

If behaviour is deemed unacceptable, you may be asked to leave the RNA or training grounds.

FAIRNESS & COACHING DECISIONS

- Coaches and managers are responsible for decisions regarding positions, court time and team rotations.
- Parents must not interfere with coaching decisions.
- Players will be rotated into different positions to develop skills and confidence.

If a player does not attend training, it is at the discretion of the coach or manager whether reduced court time applies in the following game.
